NOTIFICATION

No. SO (IS-II)7-25/2010. WHEREAS, Reportedly certain main Bunds and Canal Network were breached by the I&P Department as well as by certain local individuals to divert the heavy influx of recent floods allegedly to save the properties of influential persons which resulted in colossal loss to the properties of the inhabitants of the areas.

2. **WHEREAS,** the above incident has been flashed in media and has attracted the attention of public and it is expedient to determine the full facts of the case.

3. **NOW THEREFORE,** in exercise of the power conferred under West Pakistan Tribunals of Inquiries Ordinance, 1969 (II of 1969) the Competent Authority has been pleased to appoint following Three Member Tribunal of Inquiry to conduct inquiry in the aforesaid incident: -

4. **The Terms of Reference** of the Tribunal of Inquiry are as under: -

- i) To inquire into the causes of breaches at main Bunds including Jinnah Barrage, Taunsa Barrage, Jampur and Mithan Kot and to ascertain whether prescribed procedure was followed by I&P Department with regard to the induced breaches.
- ii) To inquire into the causes of consequent breaches in Canal Network, Roads, Bunds and Drains and to furnish detailed report with regard to cases of malfeasance, if any, on part of I&P Department, others agencies or locals.
- iii) To fix responsibility on the delinquent(s) in cases of malfeasance.
- iv) Any other recommendations that the Tribunal of the Inquiry may deem appropriate to make in the facts and circumstances of the cases.

5. The Tribunal of Inquiry shall submit its Inquiry Report at the earliest.
